### Domaine Merlin

2020 Saint-Véran “La Côte Rotie” \$66.25  
*“The 2020 Saint-Véran “La Côte Rotie comes from with a high level of active limestone, prompting Merlin to describe the wine as almost Chablis-like. It has a taut and direct, minimalist, flinty bouquet where you can almost smell that limestone. The palate is tense and very mineral-driven, plenty of salinity here...it just cries out for some fruits de mers!” 93, VM, June 2022*

2020 Pouilly-Fuissé 1er Cru Chevrères \$91.80  
*“The 2020 Pouilly-Fuissé Les Chevrères 1er Cru, one of Merlin’s most precocious Premier Crus [0.65 hectares] has a touch of menthol on the nose that conveys real vigour. The palate is very well balanced with the silky- smooth entry, fine acidity, lightly spiced with a distant tang of lemongrass and stem ginger, chamomile and touches of bergamot furnishing the finish. What more could you want in a Pouilly-Fuissé?” 94, VM, June 2022*

*“An airy, cool and layered nose features notes of green apple, white flowers and discreet hints of mineral reduction and wood. The almost painfully intense, sleek and tension-filled flavors display beautiful cut and minerality while delivering superb length on the chiseled, linear and austere finale. This is an old school CC that is rich and ripe yet it cuts-like-a-knife. Impressive.” 95, AM, Burghound, June 10, 2023.*

*“A highly restrained nose features notes of cool and ultra-pure citrus, green apple, white flowers, herbal tea and wet stone. There is a distinctly racy mouth feel to the super intense and well-delineated medium weight plus flavors that are strikingly focused on the chiseled, clean, dry and moderately austere finale that delivers stunningly good complexity. I very much like this understated effort as it is an exercise in harmony and refinement and while there is the usual taut muscularity of a classic Corton-Charlemagne, it certainly doesn't lack for elegance either. In a word, sublime.” 95, AM, Burghound, June 11, 2017.*

*“Even at 11 years of age, the still restrained and wonderfully fresh nose is only now beginning to display good layering along with hints of mandarin orange, apple, pear and white flower. There is good if not excellent underlying tension to the attractively mineral-infused flavors that finish with very good persistence and fine balance. In contrast to the wine in 750 ml (see herein for that note), this is still moderately tightly wound and while it could certainly be enjoyed now, I would be inclined to allow it another 4 to perhaps 7 years due to the large format bottling.”* 93, AM, Burghound, Oct. 10, 2022.
